77/12 Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Councillor A Long & Councillor Ms C Tindall.

78/12 Declarations of Interest

Declarations of interest were received from Councillor P Kendall & Councillor M Wood, members of Allerdale Borough Council Development Panel. Councillors P Kendall & M Wood left the room for the meeting. Councillor P Kendall returned for Item 10(2).

Resolved that the declarations of interest be recorded.

80/12 Minutes of Meeting held on 28 January 2013

Resolved that the minutes of the meeting of the Planning & Economic Development Committee held on 28 January 2013 be confirmed as a correct record & signed by the Chairman.

81/12 Maryport Town Centre Development

A presentation was given by Toni Magean, Allerdale Borough Council Town Centre Development Manager, of initial Draft Proposals for a Town Centre Development Plan. The draft plan was developed from a standard Allerdale Borough Council service plan & covered four main themes:

- 1) Street Scene
- 2) Use of Land & Buildings
- 3) Festivals, Events & Markets
- 4) Marketing & Promotion

Mr Magean advised that the different themes supported each other & that he was seeking to establish a small group to drive the plan which he hoped would operate from April 2013. More detailed arrangements were intended to support each theme through Key Projects & Actions, such as a Quarterly Issue Log, which was determined through a regular walk through Maryport by appropriate Council & other representatives, identifying matters requiring attention by responsible party. Mr Magean advised that he monitored the actions identified on the Log. Another arrangement implemented was the production of a Quarterly Newsletter on Maryport, which was aimed primarily at local businesses & which Mr Magean delivered personally.

Mr Magean responded to questions concerning a number of matters raised by members:

- Identified issues set out in the Issue Log varied in their level of priority &
 agreed implementation timescale, such that some, because of budget
 constraints, may never be addressed. Third party involvement was seen as
 important in achieving the objectives of the log.
- The town centre 'area' was based on the Allerdale Borough Council Local Plan, & covered the area from Curzon Street to the Harbour, but organisations from outside that area were still involved in improvement work.
- Mr Magean agreed to add the problem of persistent parking by commercial vehicles in inappropriate & parking restricted areas in the town centre to the Issue Log. He advised that Cumbria County Council employed Allerdale Borough Council Parking Services to manage on-street parking, & Cumbria Police also had a responsibility in this area. Part of his role was to co-ordinate these parties to produce a successful solution.
- The need to ensure Maryport Town Council was involved at the outset of proposals affecting Maryport, such as the relocation of the Job Centre & proposed closure of the Maryport Sorting Office, was noted.
- Problems with the design of Senhouse Street, particularly in terms of car
 parking arrangements & road layout, continued to be a concern, as did the
 maintenance of the paved areas, exemplified by a recent fall by a pedestrian,
 & Mr Magean noted concerns that Cumbria County Council had not acted to
 include such issues in their plans for 2012/13, as they were not seen as
 sufficiently important, & agreed that they should be added to the Issue Log.

Resolved that the report be accepted & that it be noted that Mr Magean wanted to work with The Town Council to make improvements to the plan.
